## The Great Brutish Make-off - Part II: The Technical Challenge

A sketch in three parts, for five non-gender-specific characters. The character PERFECTO 3000 doesn't appear until Part III. There are references to items that could all be mimed, or you could have stand-in props. It could be funny for everyone to potentially *try* different British accents, but that would depend largely on the players, and basically no Britons find it amusing. Which is fair.

## **CHARACTERS**:

CONTESTANT 1 - a confident perfectionist CONTESTANT 2 - a slacker CONTESTANT 3 - an "everyperson", a little insecure HOST - human and accessible, but still a showperson PERFECTO 3000 - an eerily friendly android

LIGHTS UP on CONTESTANTS 1,2, and 3, each behind their own respective tables, or, their "stations". CONTESTANTS 1 & 2 are slightly downstage of CONTESTANT 3, who is in the middle. The HOST begins as the lights come up.

**HOST** 

3...2...1 - that's time! Hands up!

The CONTESTANTS basically recreate what they did before. CONTESTANT 2 is on their phone already.

And now on to our second part of today's Make-off: the technical challenge. Here our contestants were given a specific assignment, and could only use the provided tools and ingredients. In this case: a tiramisu creme brûlée, with raspberry confit (*pronounced cone-FEE*) and spun sugar tower with a minimum height of...

three feet. As for the allowed tools and ingredients, we gave you: rice krispies, condensed milk, and a wooden spoon! Let's see what they made!

Contestant number one.

	You're welcome?
	Well, I don't know how you'll do in the scoring. Perfect as those completely identical soufflés are, it wasn't the assigned technical challenge. So yea. Moving on! Contestant number two, let's see what you've made.
HOST walks over to CONTESTANT 2, who is still on their phone. HOST looks down at their station.	

It looks like you have a post-it note. And on it, you've written the word, "farts." CONTESTANT 2 looks up at HOST for a second just to chuckle. **CONTESTANT 2** Hehe Then back to their phone. HOST stares at CONTESTANT 2, beat, the post-it, beat, CONTESTANT 2, beat **HOST** Contestant number three! What did you make? **CONTESTANT 3** nervously Oh. Ok. Well, umm. I had some real trouble with this one. **HOST** Let's just see what you made. CONTESTANT 3 uncovers their dish. **HOST** surprised Rice Krispy treats. **CONTESTANT 3** Yea. **HOST** Ok. Hmm. I have questions. **CONTESTANT 3** still nervous Ok. HOST How... did you make these without marshmallows? **CONTESTANT 3** gulp Well. I... um... I didn't.

**HOST** 

You didn't what?

## **CONTESTANT 3**

timidly at first

I didn't make them without marshmallows.

then explosively apologetic

I used marshmallows! I'm sorry, I know I wasn't supposed to, but I couldn't make the thing that we were supposed to make, and I wasn't even sure what that was, and I didn't know what to do so I just made the first thing that came to my mind, and I saw the rice krispies, and I just happened to have some marshmallows with me...

HOST

You just happened to have marshmallows?

**CONTESTANT 3** 

Yea, doesn't everyone?

**HOST** 

No, I don't think so.

## **CONTESTANT 3**

Ok, well — I do. Or did. So I made these since I figured it was better that I *try* to make something. So… here they are.

**HOST** 

You even made them into little hearts.

**CONTESTANT 3** 

Maybe I should've cut them into letters and spelled "farts."

**CONTESTANT 2** 

Hehe

**HOST** 

not amused

Well, you obviously know that you broke the rules. Still, this proved to be a tough challenge for you all. Perhaps it will all come down to the final round: The Showstopper! For this final challenge, you must make and present, a person!

**CONTESTANT 3** 

What?

Lights out
