

LESSON 1 GOD MADE MY EARS

ENTRANCE

- 1. Before Buds enter the room, have some fun music playing in the background.
- 2. As the little Buds enter, ask them to make a "shhhhh" sound with a finger over their lips.
- 3. Have them all sit in a circle.

CIRCLE CHECK-IN

Sit in a circle with your Buds and encourage lively responses.

SAY
What is something
you heard this week?

SAY
Let us all put our ears
to the floor and see if
we can hear anything
below us.

SAY
If we're all really quiet,
what sounds can you
hear in the building?

SAY Who can wiggle their ears?

REPEAT AFTER ME: GOD MADE ME

Stand up and follow the prompts below:

LEADER

"God"



Action: Buds repeat "God" and point up with both arms.

LEADER

"Made"



Action: Buds repeat "Made" with their fists on top of each other, making a twisting motion in opposite directions with both wrists.

LEADER

"Me!"



Action: Buds repeat, "Me!" with two thumbs pointing towards their chest.

"Now, all together: God made me!"

ACTION

Buds repeat "God made me!" with motions.

REPEAT AFTER ME: GOD MADE MY EARS

Follow the prompts below:

LEADER

"God"



Action: Buds repeat "God" and point up with both arms.

"Made"



Action: Buds repeat "Made" with their fists on top of each other, making a twisting motion in opposite directions with both wrists.

LEADER

"My"



Action: Buds repeat "My" with two thumbs pointing towards their chest.

LEADER

"Ears!"



Action: Buds repeat "Ears!" while pointing to both ears.

"Let's put it all together: God made my ears!"

ACTION

Buds repeat, "God made my ears!"

CIRCLE ACTIVITY: SOUNDS

Stand into a circle and encourage lively responses.

SAY
What's the loudest sound you can make?

SAY What's the quietest sound you can make? SAY What's the silliest sound you can make?


CIRCLE ACTIVITY: BROKEN TELEPHONE

How to Play: Instruct your Buds to remain in a circle from the previous activity and tell them they're going to play a fun round of Broken Telephone. To play, whisper a mystery phrase from the prompts provided on the following page to one Bud. Then, instruct the Bud to whisper the same phrase to the Bud next to them. Buds will continue whispering the phrase around the circle until it reaches the final Bud. The last Bud announces the mystery phrase out loud.

Play three rounds with the prompts below and prepare for some silly responses!



Zoom! Wee-Woo!

Look up! There's a bunch of planes!

BUDS

Zoom! Grrrr! Woosh!

LEADER

Oh, my! It's so windy outside!

BUDS

Woosh! Shhhhh!

LEADER

Such a lovely day in the park, but this swing is squeaky!

BUDS

Eeeeeek Squeak

LEADER

Yikes! A slithering snake!

BUDS

Ssssssss

LEADER

What a funny girl! Everyone is laughing at her jokes!

BUDS

Ha Ha Ha!

Uh-oh! Sounds like we woke up the baby. Now they're crying!

BUDS

Wahhh!

LEADER

I see a beautiful horse running around the farm.

BUDS

Neigh Clop! Clop! Clop!

LEADER

Look at those silly ducks playing in the pond!

BUDS

Quack Splash

LEADER


Who made your ears?

BUDS

"God made my ears!"

(with actions from the beginning of class.)

CIRCLE CHECK-OUT



CLOSING PRAYER

Sit with crossed legs and clasp hands together in a prayer position.

Dear God, thank you for giving us such wonderful ears to hear all of the beauty you created in this world! Amen.

EXIT

SAY "When you exit the room, whisper a silly sound in my ear, and I'll whisper it back."

LESSON 2 GOD MADE MY FACE

ENTRANCE

- 1. Before Buds enter the room, have some fun music playing in the background.
- 2. As the little Buds enter, ask them to sit in the circle with big smiles.

CIRCLE CHECK-IN

Sit in a circle with your Buds and encourage lively responses.

SAY

I'm going to ask how each of you is feeling, but I'd like you to respond with a big expression on your face instead of words.

REPEAT AFTER ME: GOD MADE ME

Follow the prompts below:

LEADER

"God"



Action: Buds repeat "God" and point up with both arms.

LEADER

"Made"



Action: Buds repeat "Made" with their fists on top of each other, making a twisting motion in opposite directions with both wrists.

LEADER

Action: Buds repeat "Me!" with two thumbs pointing towards their chest.

"Now, all together: God made me!"

SAY "Now, we're going to allow our expressions to take over our faces and our whole bodies! Let's pretend together!"

AH! A monster is coming! It's so scary!

BUDS

Fear Terror Running around

LEADER

Oh, wow. What a beautiful sunset.

BUDS

Awe Wonder Sigh Relaxed faces

LEADER

Yikes, we're running late for school!

BUDS

Rushing Frantic Fast movements

LEADER

Shhh... the baby is sleeping. We can't make a sound.

BUDS

Shushing
Tip-toeing
Exaggerated movements
(that are quiet)

LEADER

Bam! Thunder and lightning! Quick, let's huddle up so we can feel safe!

BUDS

Concerned Fearful Nervous Huddled together

Brrrr! It's cold!

BUDS

Shivering Chattering teeth

LEADER

Woah, it suddenly got really hot! The sun is blazing!

BUDS

Panting
Wiping brows
Fanning themselves
Tongues out

LEADER

Wow! You made it to the top of the mountain! You must be so exhausted from climbing.

BUDS

Slow movements Hunched over Crawling

LEADER

Oh my, it's getting really late. You all look so tired. It's time for a nap!

BUDS

Yawning Stretching Laying down Eyes heavy

CIRCLE DISCUSSION

Bring your Buds back into a circle and encourage lively dialogue.



CIRCLE CHECK-OUT

REPEAT "God Made Me" (with actions)

REPEAT "God Made My Face" (with actions)

CLOSING PRAYER

Sit with crossed legs and clasp hands together in a prayer position.

God, thank you for giving us wonderful faces so we can express all of the amazing feelings you've gifted us with. Amen.

EXIT

SAY "As you exit, I'm going to ask how you're feeling now that class is done. When you respond, instead of using words, show me with a big expression on your face."

LESSON 3 GOD MADE MY FINGERS

ENTRANCE

- 1. Before Buds enter the room, have some fun music playing in the background.
- 2. As the little Buds enter, give each a high five or shake their hand.
- 3. Then ask them to high five or shake hands with other Buds as they enter and sit in a circle.

CIRCLE CHECK-IN

Sit in a circle with your Buds and encourage lively responses.

SAY What are some things you can do with your fingers? SAY
Should you pick your nose with your fingers?

REPEAT AFTER ME: GOD MADE ME

Follow the prompts below:

Action: Buds repeat "God" and point up with both arms.

LEADER

"Made"



Action: Buds repeat "Made" with their fists on top of each other, making a twisting motion in opposite directions with both wrists.

LEADER

"Me!"



Action: Buds repeat "Me!" with two thumbs pointing towards their chest.

"Now, all together: God made me!"

ACTION

Hold one hand out with all five fingers spread apart.

Use your other hand to point to or pinch each finger as you count each one.

SAY

1, 2, 3, 4, 5! Five fingers on this hand!

SAY

(switch hands)
1, 2, 3, 4, 5!
Five fingers on the this hand!

AROUND THE ROOM: COUNTING

SAY "Go around the room and count your neighbors' fingers."

CIRCLE DISCUSSION

Bring your Buds back into a circle and encourage lively dialogue.

SAY
What can our fingers do?

CIRCLE ACTIVITY

SAY "Let's learn about how all of our fingers are different but awesome!"

Leader
Who has the longest fingers?

Buds

Let them measure their hands with each other, palm to palm

Leader

Who has the shortest fingers?

Leader

Who can make a heart with their fingers?

Leader

Who can tap all of their fingers on the floor?

Leader

Whose fingers are as long as mine?

Leader

Who has rings or has nail polish on?

Buds

Let them measure their hands with each other, palms on the floor.

Buds

Allow them to give you all variations of heart shapes.

Buds

Allow them to mime playing the piano or creepy crawly bugs.

Buds

Let them measure their fingers with the Leader.

Buds

Let them compare and share.

AROUND THE ROOM: LET'S PRETEND

How to Play: Invite Buds to fill the space/room as inspired by each new prompt. Feel free to elaborate and embark on an imaginative journey as you go along. Encourage your Buds to play and be silly. Don't forget to add some fun music to ignite their creativity!

What do your fingers do when you're saying "Hi" to someone?

BUDS

Waving Shaking Hands

LEADER

What do your fingers do when you're crying?

Wiping tears

Who can lay on their tummies and push their bodies up only using their fingers? (keep a careful eye to prevent injury!)

Attempted planks

What do your fingers do when you're tired?

Rubbing eyes Covering mouths to yawn Cupping chin to rest head

What does it look like when you're petting a cat?

BUDS

Stroking

What do your fingers do when you're itchy?

Who can make bear claws with their fingers and roar like a bear?

Roaring, clawing bears

Sit in a circle with your Buds and encourage lively responses.

SAY

Where have your feet taken you this week?

REPEAT AFTER ME: GOD MADE ME

Follow the prompts below:

LEADER

"God"



Action: Buds repeat "God" and point up with both arms.

LEADER

"Made"



Action: Buds repeat "Made" with their fists on top of each other, making a twisting motion in opposite directions with both wrists.

LEADER

"Me!"



Action: Buds repeat "Me!" with two thumbs pointing towards their chest.

"Now, all together: God made me!"

ACTION

Buds repeat "God made me!" with motions.

REPEAT AFTER ME: GOD MADE MY FEET



DO

Ask all Buds to sit nicely in a circle and straighten their legs into the middle.



CIRCLE ACTIVITY: COUNTING

DO

Hold one foot out with all five toes spread apart.
Use the other hand to point to or pinch each toe as you count.

SAY 1, 2, 3, 4, 5! Five toes on this foot! SAY
(switch feet)
1, 2, 3, 4, 5!
Five toes on the this foot!

AROUND THE ROOM: COUNTING

SAY "Go around the room and count your neighbors' toes."

CIRCLE ACTIVITY

Stand in a circle and encourage lively responses.

SAY "Let's learn about how all of our toes are different but awesome!"

SAY
Who can stand
on their tippy-toes
the longest?

SAY Who can stand on their heels only? SAY
Who can stand
without letting
their feet touch
the ground?

AROUND THE ROOM: FOOT SHAKE

SAY

Let's go around the circle and shake feet instead of hands.


CIRCLE DISCUSSION

Bring your Buds back into a circle and encourage lively dialogue.



AROUND THE ROOM: DRAWING WITH FEET

SAY "Let's stand up and use our toes to draw things on the floor using our imagination!"



SAY "Now find a buddy and draw an imaginary picture with them on the floor with your feet."

AROUND THE ROOM: LET'S PRETEND

How to Play: Invite Buds to fill the space/room as inspired by each new prompt. Feel free to elaborate and embark on an imaginative journey as you go along. Encourage your Buds to play and be silly. Don't forget to add some fun music to ignite their creativity!

SAY "Now we're going to use our imaginations to explore all kinds of ways to use our feet! Let's pretend together!"

LEADER

We have to tiptoe and be very quiet with our feet so we don't wake the sleeping giant!

LEADER

Oh, wow! Look at all of those pretty ballerinas dancing in front of me!

LEADER

Oh, my, these are the loudest feet I've ever heard!

BUDS

Tiptoe Shushing

BUDS

Jumping Twirling Pointed toes

BUDS

Stomping Marching

These ice skaters glide so smoothly across the ice. Whoosh!

LEADER

These monkeys walk around on both their hands and feet!

LEADER

Look at those ducks waddle around, slapping their wide feet against the floor.

LEADER

Yikes! There's a bunch of alligators crawling on their bellies towards us!

LEADER

Who made your feet?

BUDS

Sliding Gliding

BUDS

Walking on hands and feet Monkey sounds

BUDS

Quacking Slapping

BUDS

Squirming

BUDS

Repeat, "God Made My Feet!" with actions from the beginning of class.

CIRCLE CHECK-OUT



REPEAT
"God Made My Feet"

(with actions)

CLOSING PRAYER

sit with crossed legs and clasp hands together in a prayer position

God, thank you for giving us such wriggly little feet to help us get around!

EXIT

SAY

As you exit the room, let's compare our feet! Are yours smaller or bigger than mine?

LESSON 5 GOD MADE MY ARMS

ENTRANCE

- 1. Before Buds enter the room, have some fun music playing in the background.
- 2. As the little Buds enter, ask them to make a secret handshake with everyone, then sit in a circle.

SAY "Walk around the room and call out "right, left" as your arms swing forward."

BUDS

Freeze Stop hand with palm forward

BUDS

Straight arms with palms touching, opening and closing like they're chomping

BUDS

Fluttering Flying Imaginary wings

BUDS

Hugs all around

BUDS

Marching Straight arms swinging

All of these carpenters are doing such a great job hammering and sawing to make this house!

LEADER

These musicians sound so great together! Look at all of the instruments they're playing!

LEADER

Let's stir the pot of stew! Mmm! Dinner smells yummy!

LEADER

Who made your arms?

BUDS

Hammering Sawing

BUDS

Pretend instruments

BUDS

Stirring

BUDS

Repeat, "God made my arms!" with actions from the beginning of class.

CIRCLE CHECK-OUT





CLOSING PRAYER

Sit with crossed legs and clasp hands together in a prayer position.

God, thank you for giving us arms so we can give each other warm hugs!

EXIT

SAY "As you exit the room, see if you can reach up and touch the top of the door frame!"

LESSON 6 GOD MADE MY LEGS




